



Polished concrete flooring

Polished concrete is a great option for modern flooring. It is durable, low maintenace and gives a sleek and high end finish to your home.

However, polished concrete can be very cold in winter. The solution for this drawback is to heat the floor. Floor heating is a low temperature heat designed to take the chill off the floor and gently radiate warmth into spaces above the floor.

The floor heating is controlled by a thermostat with a floor sensor so the floor heating will not over heat the floor, so cracking is not an issue and power bills are controlled.



Polished concrete can be installed in the slab or in the topping slab. There must be at least 30mm coverage over the pipe to the finished floor surface.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS

Expansion joints are often installed in polished concrete floors. Comfort Heat must be informed of any expansion joints in the slab so provision can be made during the installation.
